







How to Install the NAP Lockdown Browser on a laptop




Before following this step-by-step guide it is essential that any prior NAP lockdown browser is uninstalled.





Uninstall NAP 2023 or earlier versions


1. Use the Search icon	
2. Click on Uninstall	
3. You will be presented with the software applications which are currently installed	
4. Scroll down until you see NAP	
5. Click Uninstall

<p>1. Access the ACARA download page</p>	<p>https://www.assessform.edu.au/naplan-online/locked-down-browser</p>
<p>2. Click on Locked down browsers and user guides</p>	
<p>3. Choose the required Download for Windows 10 or MacOS</p>	
<p>4. Click Open to start the installation</p>	

<p>5. Allow the app to install</p>	
<p>6. Click Next</p>	
<p>7. Enter a Device Name (use your child's first name and initial)</p> <p>8. Click Next</p>	
<p>9. Click Install</p>	

<p>10. You may get a system message asking you if you wish to continue with the installation. Click Yes</p>	
<p>11. Once completed, click Finish</p>	

The NAP app is now installed.
